Moss Bag Teaching

With Liza Brown

Learn some of the foundational teachings for the moss bag (a baby carrying bag) that Cree people used and still use today.

Participants can make a small craft at the end of the session.

Talking Circle

Do you know what a talking circle is? Learn how this communication forum was used by many Indigenous groups to share thoughts, feelings and emotions. It is a powerful and effective mode of communication when a few basic protocols are implemented.

Inspirational Family Songs

The joy and art of music will be celebrated with a sing along. Join in with song, dance or an instrument if you're moved to do so. Bring your own instrument if you wish.

Beading

Basic beginner beading! Learn what materials to use to make a personal beading design and begin to create a bracelet! Some basic sewing skills are necessary. Material is provided.

Hand Drum Singing

Experience the sound of the hand drum and have a chance to try the hand drum themselves. Songs will be shared.

Moose Hair Tufting

Create designs by sewing moose and caribou hair onto felt. Tufting is used to embellish clothing, shoes, etc. Material is provided.

Beautiful art...with bark! Using a traditional Indigenous technique, learn how to create pattern and design by biting into birch bark. Material is provided.
